



Financial Grants – Frequently Asked Questions

Q – What are the windows and deadlines for applying for a grant?

A – The winter application window is December 1st – January 1st. The summer application window is June 1st – July 1st.

Q – What are the age requirements for grant applications?

A – We accept grant applications for individuals from age 5–18. Please note when applying for a grant, the child must be 5 years of age at the time of the application deadline.

Q – How may a grant be used?

A – Grant monies are for Movement and/or Speech-Language Assessments and are paid directly to the Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, and/or Speech-Language Pathologist/Therapist..

Q – Can grant monies be applied to previous services?

A – NO, grants are awarded for future services only.

Q – How do I find an Occupational Therapist (OT), Physical Therapist (PT) and/or Speech-Language Pathologist/Therapist (SLP) for assessments?

A – A good place to start is by asking your pediatrician for a referral to an OT, PT and/or SLP. See [Seeking A Diagnosis - What To Do And Expect](#) for more information.

Q – Are grants only awarded in the state of New York?

A – NO, Dyspraxia DCD America awards grants to individuals within the United States.

Q – How do I submit a grant application?

A – Download and complete the [Financial Grant Guidelines](#) and the [Financial Grant Application For OT/PT/SLP Assessment](#). All supporting documents must be submitted with the application. Completed applications may be mailed or emailed.

Q – Once my application is submitted, when will I find out if I was awarded a grant?

A – A notification email will be sent to the grant recipient within 60 days of the application deadline.

Q – If I receive a grant, when will grant monies be available?

A – Grant monies for the January 1st deadline will be available March 21st. Grants for the July 1st deadline will be available September 21st. Grant monies are paid directly to the medical provider.
